Kempton Streetscape Group Works undertaken in Kempton since May 2017

The Kempton Streetscape Group has been working closely with the Southern Midlands Council to determine and work on priority projects.





Kempton road signage Kempton road signage was replaced and updated.



General painting works as requested by community

General painting and maintenance works around the Kempton area (fencing etc.) have been completed.





Gymkhana paddock (horse drawn shed site)

Silver birch trees have been planted along the road up to the shed in the Gymkhana paddock (horse drawn shed site). Guards have been placed around them to protect them from grazing.





Footpaths

Priority sections of Kempton footpaths have been upgraded in each financial year and will continue to be upgraded as funding becomes available

Clock tower / hedge in front of Kempton Council office

Maintenance work on the clock face, mechanism and lighting was undertaken. The stone work on the tower was cleaned and the names on the marble plaque highlighted and fixed. A hedge was planted either side of the clock and at this is point is growing well.



Recreation ground and other locations – tree planting

Trees planted at the Recreation Ground to provide additional shelter. Feature trees (Oaks) were also planted and tree guards installed at the Ground. Additional trees also planted in other locations around Kemption for example at the stop-over area.



Recreation ground – entrance moved

A new entrance was created to the Recreation Ground with associated curb and guttering installed. The old entrance was fenced and a memorial seat installed.





History panel at the recreation ground

Allan Townsend, with assistance from members of the community, prepared the text and photos for a recreation ground history panel. The panel was later made and installed at the ground.

The old fence and vegetation was removed and a new fence was installed.

Silhouette (people waiting for coach)


The silhouette will be moved from its current location to the grandstand mural in the near future.
